### Seven Motivational Gifts

*“Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, whether prophecy, let us prophesy according to the proportion of faith; Or ministry, let us wait on our ministering: or he that teacheth, on teaching; Or he that exhorteth, on exhortation: he that giveth, let him do it with simplicity; he that ruleth, with diligence; he that showeth mercy, with cheerfulness” (Romans 12:6 - 8).*

• \_\_\_\_\_ (the ability to have insight into truth and to declare that truth)

• **Children with this gift have these general tendencies:**

- Intense
- Perfectionist
- Active
- Absolutistic (see things in black and white, not in shades of gray)
- People oriented
- Find pretend play uninteresting
- Go to extremes as students - excel or flunk
- Prefer active play and athletics
- Show verbal authority along with persuasive rhetoric. This verbal authority is their main identifying characteristic.

• **Problems with the gift of prophecy include:**

- May give up quickly on people if disappointed in people's response to the truth that has been given them.
- May give correction without love.
- May rely on persuasive rhetoric rather than the Holy Spirit.

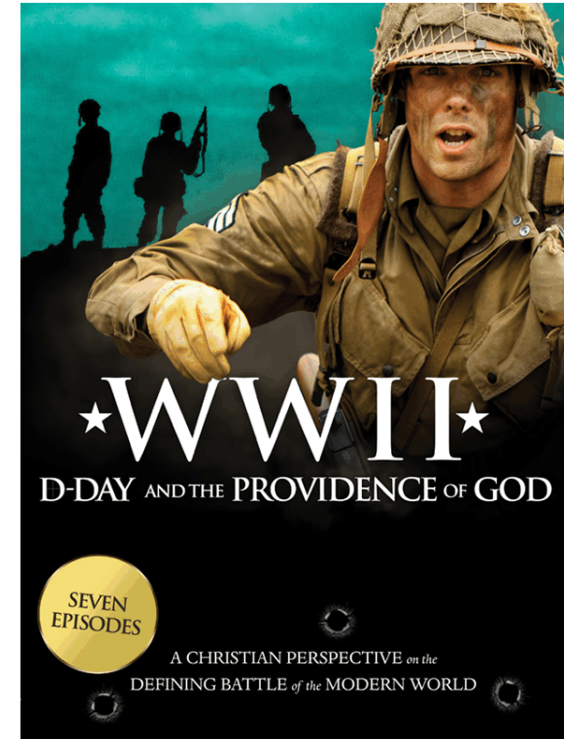
