(To Assist You In Your Study, We Encourage You To Follow Along Using The Outline Below)

### Seven Motivational Gifts

“Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, whether prophecy, let us prophesy according to the proportion of faith; Or ministry, let us wait on our ministering: or he that teacheth, on teaching; Or he that exhorteth, on exhortation: he that giveth, let him do it with simplicity; he that ruleth, with diligence; he that showeth mercy, with cheerfulness” (Romans 12:6 - 8).

- \_\_\_\_\_ (ability to unwaveringly carry out long range and comprehensive goals by organizing others to be responsible for details)
- **Tendencies:**

1. Personality full of zeal and enthusiasm	2. Wide range of interests
3. Forward conduct, curious, investigative	4. Joiners, volunteers, runners for offices
5. Have inner drive to be first	6. Well liked by all ages
7. Enjoy being constantly on the go	8. Collectors of hobby items, will join all contests
9. Planners	10. Outspoken
11. Systematic in approach to life (lay out clothes for next day, make lists of things to be done, etc.)	12. Wide reading interests
13. Enjoy playing with toys when small, but rather play with other children when older	14. Enjoy pets, but don't follow through with caring for them.

- **Problems:**
  1. Won't offer gift unless asked
  2. Goal oriented - indifferent to people in the way
  3. May manipulate people to achieve goals

● **Characteristics:**

1. An ability to see the \_\_\_\_\_ and to visualize the final results of a major undertaking.
2. An ability to break down the major \_\_\_\_\_ into smaller, achievable tasks.
3. A motivation to \_\_\_\_\_ that for which he is responsible.
4. An ability to know what \_\_\_\_\_ are available (time, knowledge, etc.) and needed to reach a goal.
5. An ability to know what can and cannot be \_\_\_\_\_ .
6. A tendency to remove himself from distracting \_\_\_\_\_ in order to focus on the ultimate goal.
7. A willingness to endure \_\_\_\_\_ .
8. A need for \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ from those being directed and served.
9. A tendency to assume \_\_\_\_\_ if no structured leadership exists.
10. A desire to \_\_\_\_\_ tasks as soon as well as possible.
11. A desire to move on to a new \_\_\_\_\_ when one is quickly completed.

● **Misunderstandings:**

1. The ability to delegate responsibility may appear as \_\_\_\_\_ in avoiding work.
2. Willingness to endure \_\_\_\_\_ may appear to be calloused, insensitive, and uncaring.
3. The neglect in explaining \_\_\_\_\_ tasks need to be done may prompt workers to feel that they are being “used” or misused.

4. The viewing of people as \_\_\_\_\_ may appear that projects are more important than people.
5. The desire to complete the task \_\_\_\_\_ may appear as insensitivity to the priorities and feelings of others.

## **2012 MEN’S ADVANCE**

**Friday, April 27, 2012 at 7:00 p.m.  
and Saturday, April 28 from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.**

The Men's Advance has been hosted by Bible Baptist Church of Stillwater for over ten years and is attended by men from all across the Midwest. The goal of the Men's Advance is to impact the lives of men spiritually to make a difference in their homes, churches, relationships and community. The meeting runs on a two-day format, beginning this year at 7:00 P.M. on Friday, April 27, 2012, and concluding at approximately 3:00 P.M. on Saturday, April 28.

This year, we will again meet at the Payne County Expo Center, just east of Stillwater. Meals are provided on-site to allow the men more time to fellowship with one another, and include a full smoked meat dinner Friday night, complete breakfast Saturday morning, and a great lunch Saturday afternoon. In addition to the Advance, a golf tournament is open to all attendees and precede the Advance earlier on Friday.

The service times and break-out sessions are the focus of the event. Here, the men are challenged to examine their lives in the light of God's Word. Both humorous and contemplative skits are interspersed to reinforce the truths presented. Special music provided by the Bible Baptist Church Men's Group and others adds to the wonderful congregational hymns, including the traditional “It Is Well With My Soul” finale.
