Seven Motivational Gifts

“Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, whether prophecy, let us prophesy according to the proportion of faith; Or ministry, let us wait on our ministering: or he that teacheth, on teaching; Or he that exhorteth, on exhortation: he that giveth, let him do it with simplicity; he that ruleth, with diligence; he that showeth mercy, with cheerfulness” (Romans 12:6 - 8).

1. Lovable, cuddly children
2. Shy, gentle, may be clingers, frightened by loud noises
3. Often will not stand up for own rights, but will defend rights of others
4. Drawn to underdogs, aged and sick

6. Love everyone, but will have small circle of friends
7. May assume personal guilt for difficulties parents have
8. Very emotional
9. Sensitive to people in compassionate ways

● **Problems:**

1. May take ability to feel deeply and apply to self in self pity and guilt
2. Overly sensitive
3. Resentful to others who are not as sensitive as they are
4. Can fail to be firm when necessary
5. Very sensitive to strain - will take peace at any cost

7. Easily depressed

Special music provided by the Bible Baptist Church Men's Group and others adds to the wonderful congregational hymns, including the traditional "It Is Well With My Soul" finale.
