#### WHAT'S GOING ON IN THE **SOUTHERN BAPTIST CONVENTION?**

Last week, top Southern Baptist leaders released a once-secret applicability, its prophetic voice. If the Bible is not God's Word, list naming hundreds of pastors and church workers who have been accused of sexual abuse. The list includes hundreds of entries from alleged cases spanning mainly from 2000 to 2019.

> The decision to release the 205-page list Thursday evening came after independent firm Guidepost Solutions on Sunday, May 22, 2022, unveiled an explosive report on its findings into a probe into alleged past abuses within the denomination.

> The probe found that the Southern Baptist Convention's Executive Committee had mishandled abuse claims and stonewalled survivors. The investigation was requested by the executive committee after it faced growing pressure for an external probe into abuse allegations.

> The Guidepost report had alleged that D. August Boto, the former vice president and general counsel of the committee, and former SBC spokesman Roger Oldham, who both retired in 2019, had kept a private list of allegations. The list was not believed to be widely known within the committee and church staff, the investigation found.

> In the report, Guidepost said that for years, survivors had been contacting the Southern Baptist Convention Executive Committee "to report child molesters and other abusers who were

in the pulpit or employed as church staff."

"They made phone calls, mailed letters, sent emails, appeared at SBC and EC meetings, held rallies, and contacted the press...only to be met, time and time again, with resistance, stonewalling, and even outright hostility from some within the EC," it said.

Despite keeping a list of allegations, Guidepost said "there is no indication that Dr. Oldham, Mr. Boto, or anyone else, took any action to ensure that the accused ministers were no longer in positions of power at SBC churches."

Even though the Southern Baptist Convention compiled the list of hundreds of ministers accused of sexual abuse, it's top executive, former Northwest Arkansas Pastor Ronnie Floyd, opposed making it public and chose not to examine the list himself, according to the independent report commissioned by the denomination and made public this week.

Floyd, president and chief executive officer of the Convention's executive committee, and other key leaders tried to block the type of sweeping investigation sought by delegates--known as messengers--to the denomination's June annual meeting in Nashville, the 288-page report said.

Floyd and several other officials resigned in October after the executive committee voted to waive attorney-client privilege, as the messengers had requested, enabling investigators to see documents that would otherwise have been shielded from view.

For years, officials in the denomination's Nashville headquarters worked hard to shield the body from legal liability. but failed to take the steps necessary to protect the people in the pews, the report indicates. That emphasis, which predated Floyd's appointment to the post in April 2019, remained during his tenure, the report indicated.

Guidepost Solutions, the investigative firm that prepared the report, portrayed Floyd as an impediment to fixing the system.

"Dr. Floyd's resistance to reform as SBC President is disappointing, given that he spoke out against clergy abuse as a pastor, writing in 2014 that: 'Furthermore, we can and must hold up the issue. Yes, we are a convention of autonomous churches, but we need to continue to sound the alarm on national, state and the association level, calling churches to protect children in their care," the report quoted him as saying.

At last year's gathering of messengers at the Southern Baptist Convention, Floyd advocated for a "limited review," the report said. Ultimately, the messengers opted to give investigators a "wider purview" and to ensure that the investigation would be overseen by a task force, rather than the executive committee itself, the report stated.

For 15 years or more, advocates for child sex abuse survivors have urged the convention to compile a list of those in ministry credibly accused of preying on congregants. Top denominational leadership, and the attorneys who advised them, repeatedly rebuffed those requests. Nonetheless, officials compiled an

in-house list of alleged abusers that was kept secret, the report revealed. Officials in Nashville took no steps to ensure that the people on the lists were removed from the ministry, it said.

In a May 2019 email, Executive Committee Vice President Dr. Roger "Sing" Oldham told Floyd that, for the past decade, he had been "regularly sending [Executive Committee General Counsel] Augie [Boto] news reports of Baptist ministers who are arrested for sexual abuse for his awareness."

Boto replied: "Yes. We are collecting them, and may even post them in some way, but we'd have to really examine the potential liabilities that would stem therefrom."

Ultimately, the executive committee opted not to share the information.

"Despite collecting these reports for more than 10 years, there is no indication that Dr. Oldham, Mr. Boto, or anyone else, took any action to ensure that the accused ministers were no longer in positions of power at SBC churches. The most recent list prepared by the [executive committee] staff member contained the names of 703 abusers, with 409 believed to be [Southern Baptist Convention affiliated at some point in time."

#### THE BOTTOM LINE IS -

- ☐ The "conservative resurgence" of the Southern Baptist Convention of the 1980s-early 2000s, failed. If you assk students at SBC seminaries today if they believe the "blessings" of "white privilege" are inherently sinful, if they believe the white race is guilty of oppressing minorities, if Jesus' primary mission was liberating the physically and emotionally oppressed, and similar questions, and you'll find that SBC seminaries and their students, are buying into the lies propagated by postmodernism, the social justice movement, Critical Race Theory (CRT), and similar ungodly ideologies.

It is strengthening its grip, especially in the seminaries, and is now spilling over into the SBC-affiliated churches as well. #### HILLSONG MUSIC IS A GATEWAY DRUG TO APOSTASY. AND CHURCHES ARE DEALING IT TO THEIR PEOPLE

Over the years, Christian observers have watched a string of high-profile apostasies take place, including Marty Sampson, one of the most prominent Hillsong music artists in the organization's history. Sampson is not the only one, though. Hillsong's senior pastor and founder, Brian Houston, along with several of the various campus pastors and leaders have fallen into temptation and become involved in sex scandals.

Hillsong Church is not a church, but a breeding ground for false converts — and it is filled with false teachers. Hillsong has practically merged with the Roman Catholic Church and has even held Catholic Masses at its conferences and it has completely embraced the Word of Faith heresy.

This is an updated article that seeks to explain why churches should not be feeding their people this drug.

By far, the greatest evil in the church are the works of darkness that creep in unaware to dilute the true Gospel of Jesus Christ, while building a false church that serves the interest of man. Her recent capitulation to Rome–the Vatican, at an ecumenical worship event lead by the Roman Catholic Church, Don Moen, an American "worship leader" with close ties to Zschech and Hillsong, who also participated in the event was quoted as saying in an article at Christianity Today,

"This ecumenical event brings Protestants, Catholics, and Jews together as we pray for our brothers and sisters in Christ who are being martyred and persecuted all over the world today."

She refers to the anti-biblical teachings and practices of Roman Catholicism as "different characteristics, faces, tastes, and giftings.. yet a DNA running through our veins that draw us

The Holy Spirit does not lead Christians into an ecumenical, multi-god "praise and worship" event put on by the ancient enemy of the Gospel, the Roman Catholic Church. It's quite the opposite. I had to continually remind myself that I was there to announce and declare the Kingdom of God and not to fault find but to be aware and awake

He is a contributing author of Heal Us, Emmanuel: A Call for Racial **Reconciliation, Representation, and Unity in the Church.** Kwon spends the vast majority of his time inciting racial division between whites and other ethnicities on social media while calling for such outlandish measures as slave reparations.

Brian McLaren says that we should welcome "the disillusioned and the doubters" (A Generous Orthodoxy, p. 172).

While it is right to ask sincere questions in the honest search for the truth, it is evil to entertain questions that deny Bible truth. If the Bible says all unbelievers will suffer conscious eternal torment in fire, which it does, we must not entertain questions that speculate if this is a just punishment. If the Bible claims to be the infallible Word of God, which it does, we are not to question how this could be possible. If the Bible says we are not to love this world, which it does, we are not to question whether this might be a narrow, "legalistic" position.

Our questions must be controlled by the Bible, not the Bible by our questions. If a church member asks a question about the deity of Christ or hell, etc., he should be instructed from Scripture. If, though, he refuses to accept the Bible's teaching and persists in his doubt and unbelief and chooses heresy over the truth, he must be put out of the congregation. A qualification for church membership is to continue "steadfastly in the apostles" doctrine" (Acts 2:42).

Further, the Bible exalts faith over doubt. "But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him" (Heb. 11:6).
