Why Church Attendance Is **STILL** So Important

his year, with all the changes facing churches, demonstrates why church attendance is still important. An online post from a major ministry struck

a nerve when it stated the necessity of church attendance for your growth as a believer in Christ.

It's surprising to me how many Christians struggle with the idea of church attendance. We are at a crossroads in our nation on the importance of going to church. According to research, church attendance has remained virtually the same percent of our national population for the past 70 years, however, this still means there are a huge number of American Christians who are not active in a local church - in the tens of millions.

Of course, this isn't a new problem. Since the beginning of Christianity, the early leaders had to challenge this mindset, saying, "Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching" (Hebrews 10:25).

Church Attendance Still Matters

A popular Christian social media catch-phrase is, "You don't go to church, you are the church." While I get the sentiment in some ways, this is an unhealthy view, pitting "being the church" and "going to church" against each other. If we are truly "the church," then we will surely get together with other believers regularly. We cannot "be" the church, if we don't "go" to church. Not fully

The "church" never connotes a single, individual, "lone ranger" Christian just going about his Christian duties and never gathering together to worship with other believers. The "church" by its very nature means multiple believers: "For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them" (Matthew 18:20).

This is both the biblical and historical pattern set forth for us by the first followers of Jesus. They would get together weekly to worship God together, and at times even daily. They would also share community together in each other's homes. Paul and the other Apostle's letters were actually sent to these church communities that gathered in various cities to be read aloud together. Church means getting together with other believers to worship Jesus Christ, and hear the Scriptures together, and encourage one another in the faith.

Craig Groeschel shared recently,

"There is something better. To worship God together and be committed to worship Him together, to hear His Word together. Do not reduce church to listening to a podcast - it's **SO MUCH MORE than that.** It's community. It's worshiping with other, praying for others, hurting with others, serving others, being involved in the lives of others."

Christian Commentator Banned From Twitter for "Misgendering" Says She Won't Budge

Christian author, speaker, and conservative commentator, Allie Beth Stuckey, was banned from Twitter on Thursday for "misgendering" a transgender athlete.

On August 2, Stuckey tweeted in reference to transgender athlete, Laurel Hubbard, as a "he" and subsequently received a suspension notice from Twitter for breaking the rules against "hateful conduct."

"You may not promote violence against, threaten, or harass other people on the basis of race, ethnicity, national origin, sexual orientation, gender, gender identity, religious affiliation, age, disability, or serious disease," the email stated.

In response to her suspension, Stuckey said in an interview with Faithwire that she would not be budging on this issue because "Biology matters. Sex differences matter," and "Facts matter."

"As a Christian, I know two things to be true," Stuckey wrote in an email. "One, all people are made in God's image, no matter their stated identity and, therefore, have immense value and, two, men are men and women are women."

Stuckey has become a prominent voice within Reformed Evangelical circles, even speaking at G3 Conferences.

In 2019, Stuckey made headlines after calling out Beth Moore for holding to "unbiblical, worldly theology," stating:

This is one of quite a few myths that Christian women believe, not as much Christian men...a lot of women preach the Bible with this me-first or me-centered mentality-that everything in the Bible is about them, and they've kind of reduced Jesus to this emotionally supportive boyfriend that is almost like their gal-pal who just sits around and tells them how awesome their hair is and how great their personality is. I've always disliked that about female Christianity because that's not who Jesus is.

Son of Former SBC President Comes Completely Out of the Closet, Admits He's a Homosexual

Though Jonathan Merritt, the son of the former Southern Baptist Convention president, James Merritt, was "outed" for having a gay encounter with another man at a Christian conference several years ago, he's never actually openly and fully admitted that he is gay.

On August 4, 2021, all that changed.

In a post on Instagram, Jonathan Merritt came completely out of the closet admitting that the life he lives publicly is "disconnected" from his private life, and that he wants to set the record straight before he turns 40. In the post, he writes,

"Some of you may not know this part of my story. I have learned to live authentically in my personal life, sharing with friends the fullness of who I am. But the experience of being

outed left me bruised and untrusting and dead dog afraid to offer these vulnerable parts of myself for public consumption and critique. So, I haven't really written about my identity online."

Here, Merritt is correct in stating that he's never publicly admitted this. He says it's because he doesn't "want to live fearful of the opinions of strangers or the venom of bigots." Of course, everyone knows those "bigots" are simply people who actually believe the Word of God to be true.

Merritt continues to describe himself as a Christian and says that he's had to "learn to love the delightful human that God made when God made me."

He continues, "So today, I'm raising a glass to my full and complete self—a gay man, beloved by God, who has endured the worst the world could throw at him and fought his way to health and wholeness."

1. Don't Be Surprised

God's Word prophesies the condition of the world and of professing Christianity, and this is exactly what we see in our

2. Make Sure You Are Saved

3. Be Ready for the Shout

Amen" (Matthew 28:18-20).

6. Pray

"I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty. For this is good and

caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in acceptable in the sight of God our Saviour; Who will have all the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord. Wherefore men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth" (I Timothy 2:1-4).

Render therefore to all their dues: tribute to whom tribute is due; custom to whom custom; fear to whom fear; honour to whom honour" (Romans 13:1-7).
